ENGLISH

In English we will be writing narrative stories, focussing on settings and characters. We will be writing newspaper reports and letters. We will be looking at poetry and expanding our use of vocabulary as well as using topic related technical words. Children will also be working on their performance skills, speaking and listening and use of expression.

TOPIC—Scrumdiddlyumptious

We will be exploring the topic of food. We will know the different food groups, how eating healthy can help to keep our bodies strong and how we can sort healthy and unhealthy foods. We will be inventing our own chocolate/sweet and persuading people to 'buy' it.

MATHS

In maths we will be understanding place value of 3 digit numbers and identifying Hundreds, Tens and Ones. We will be partitioning numbers in different ways and counting in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100. We will compare and order numbers and be able to find 100 more or less than a given number.

PSHCE/RE

In RE we will be looking at Judaism and how values inform an important part of religious life.

We will be visiting Morisons to look at food, where our food comes from and understand how some food is made.

SCIENCE

In science we will be looking at food groups, reversible and irreversible changes, investigations and how to carry out a fair test.

We will be observing and drawing from real life fruits and vegetables. We will also look at their shape, colour and form. We will also be sampling different foods and using sounds to represent different foods.
